

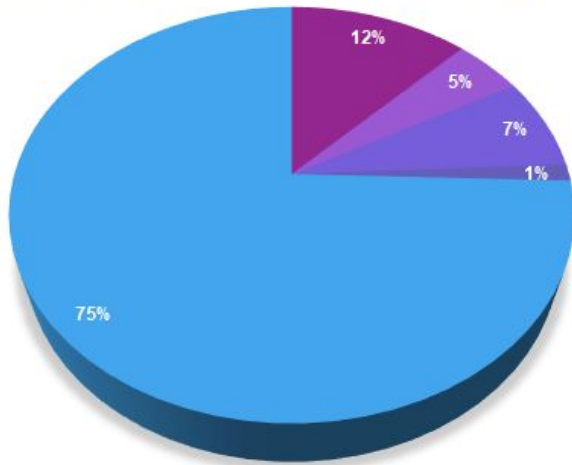

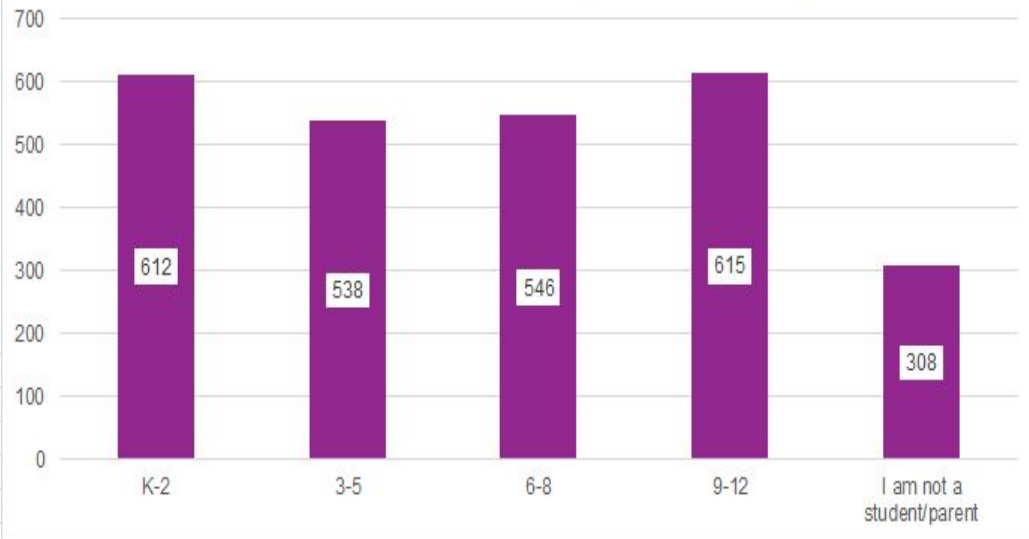

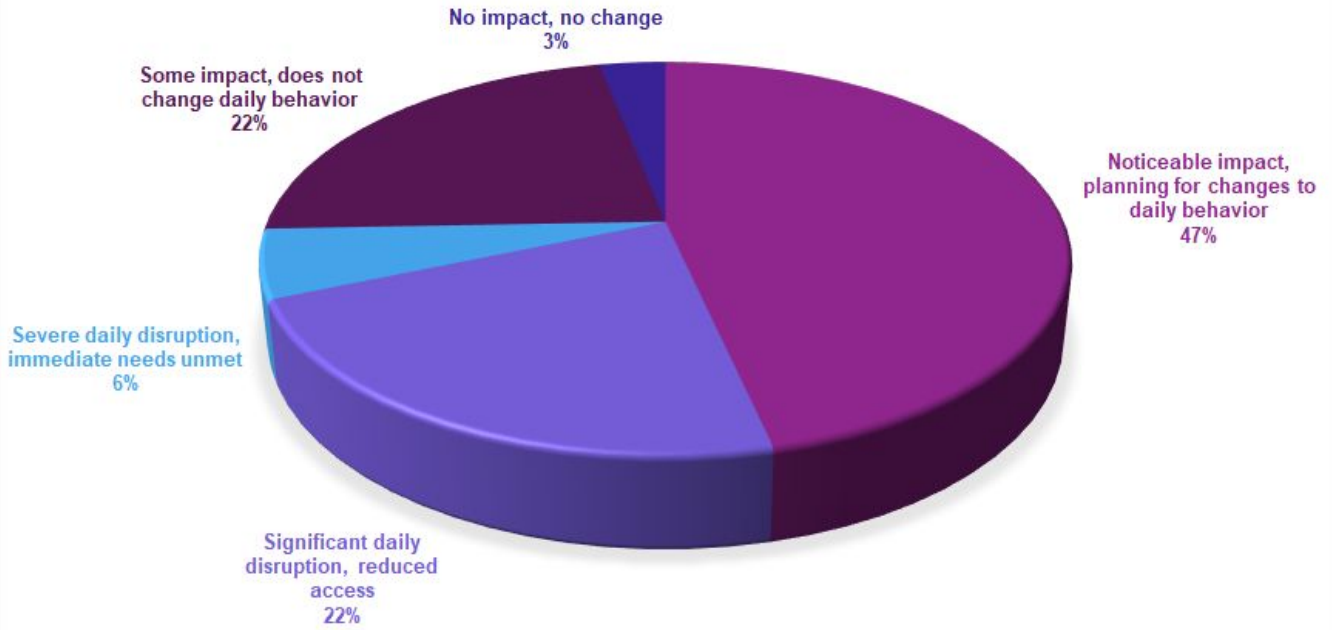
**If you are a parent/student, which grade band represents you/your child(ren)? Please include each grade band that applies.**

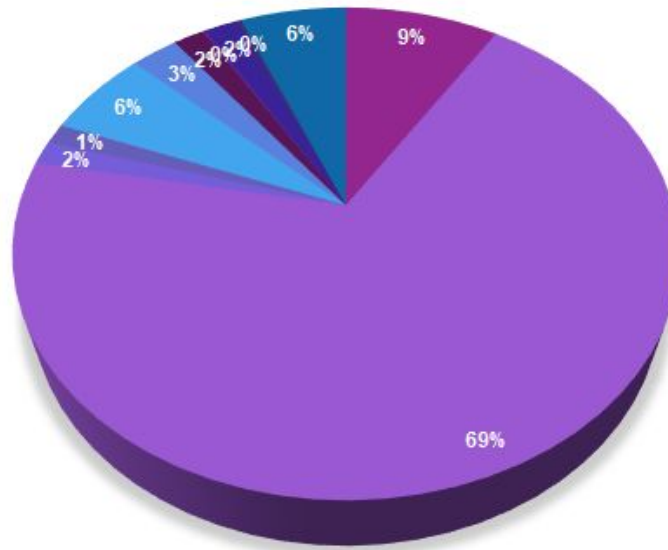
**OVERALL, HOW MUCH HAS THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AFFECTED YOU AND YOUR HOUSEHOLD?**

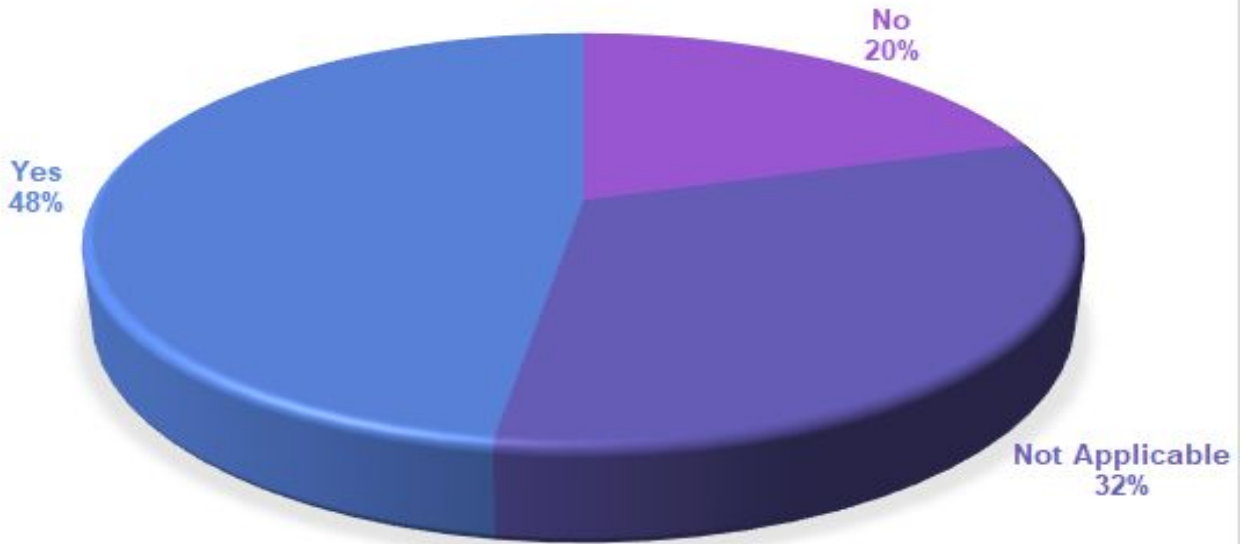

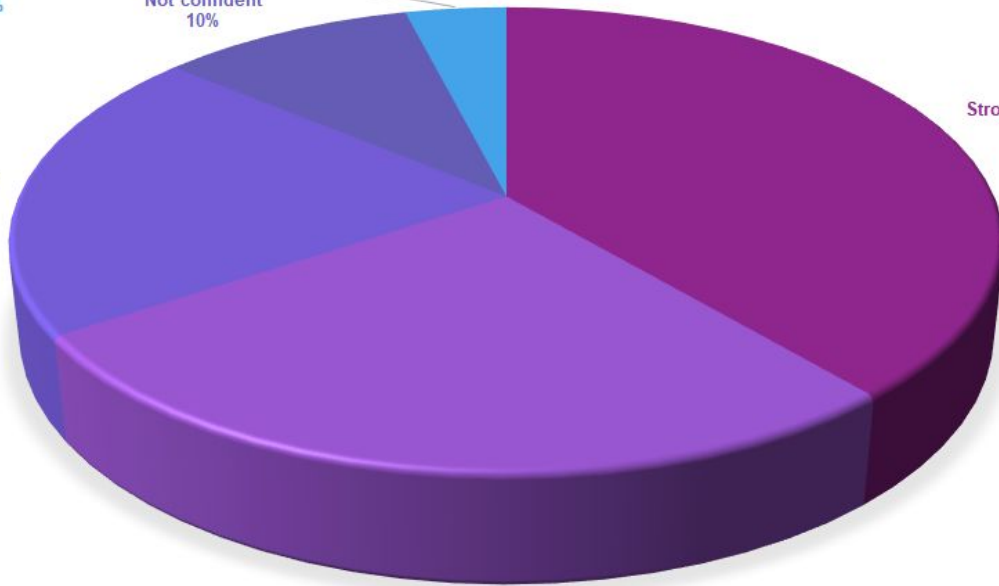

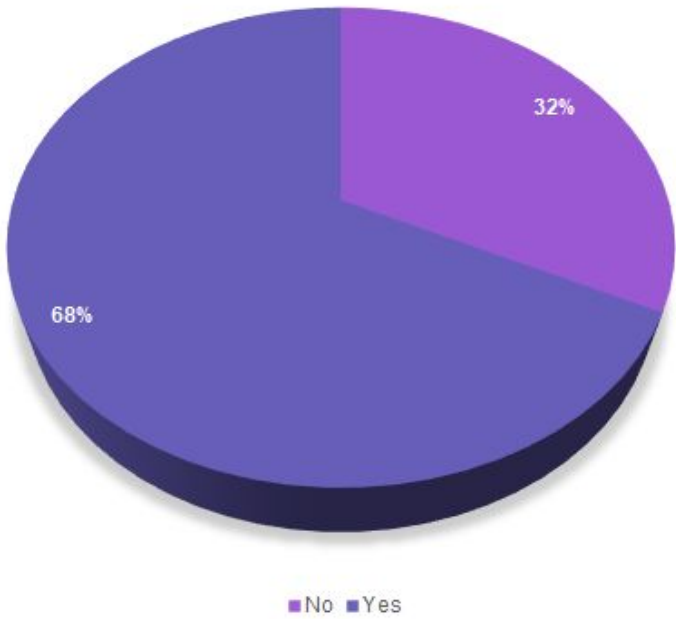

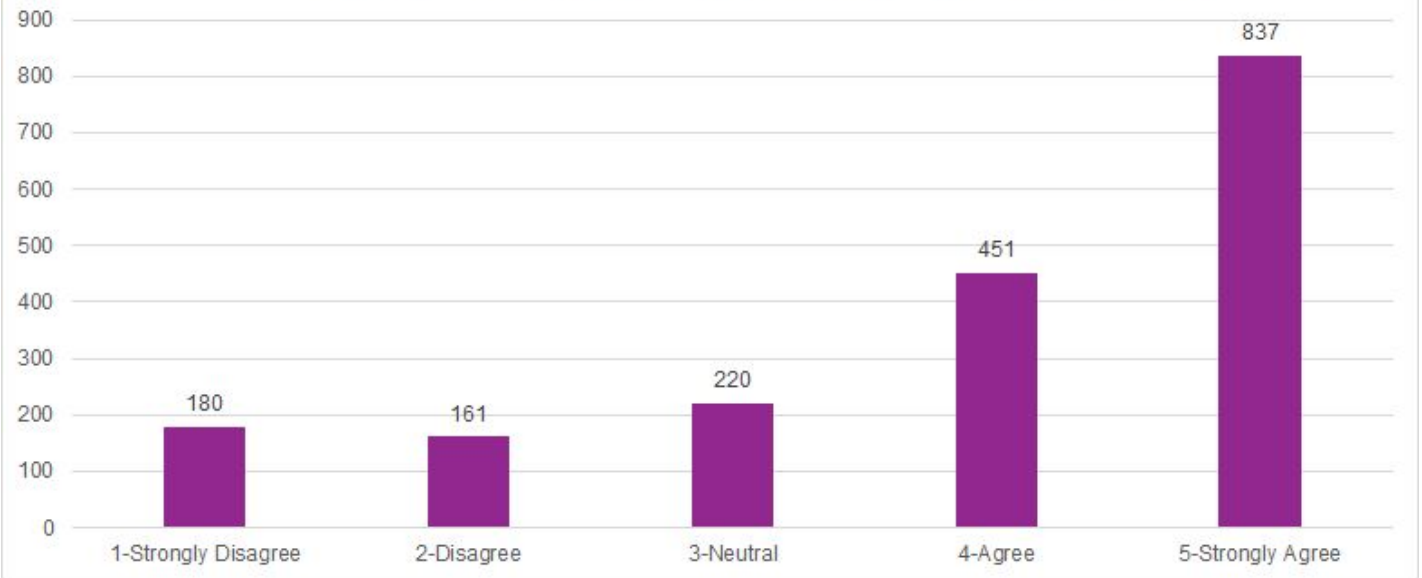
**If you have a child that will be of Kindergarten age this Fall, will you be enrolling them in the district if students return to school in September?**

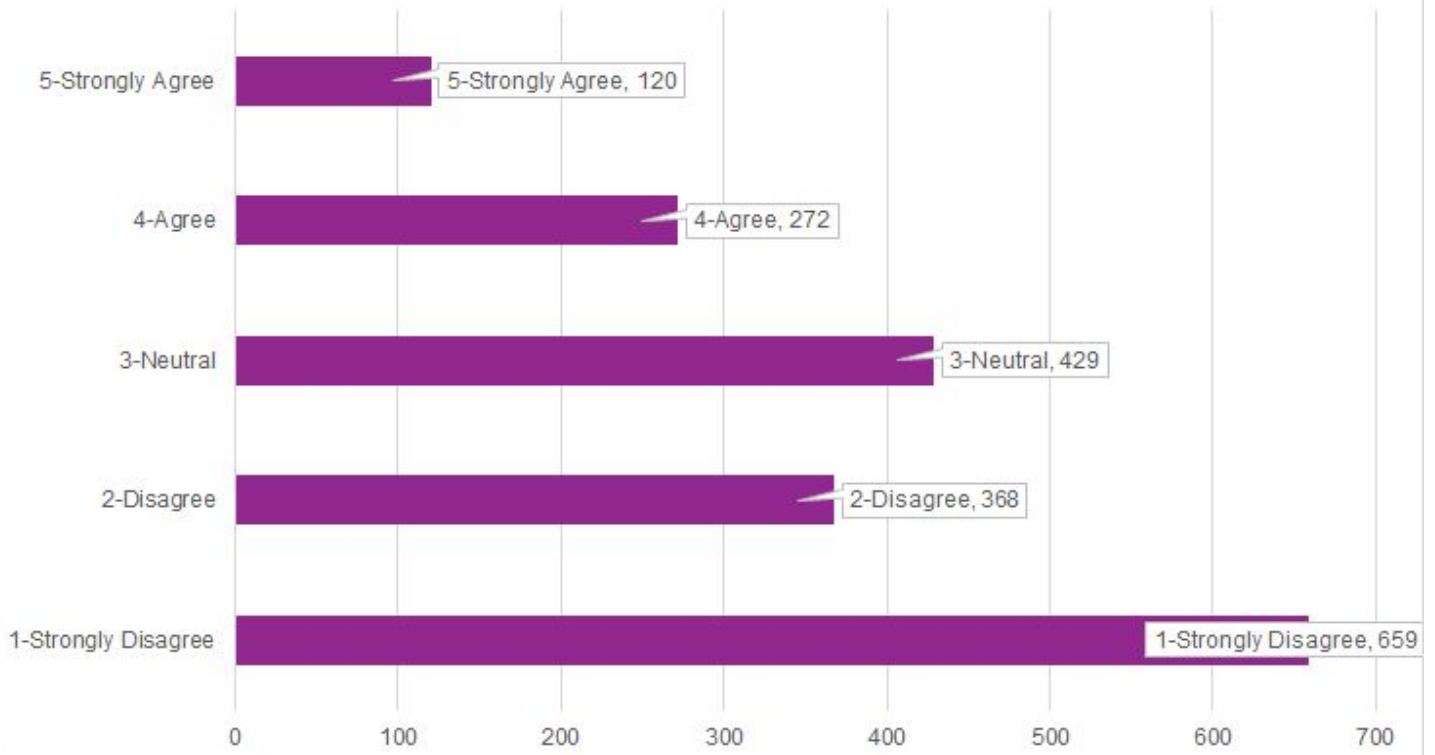

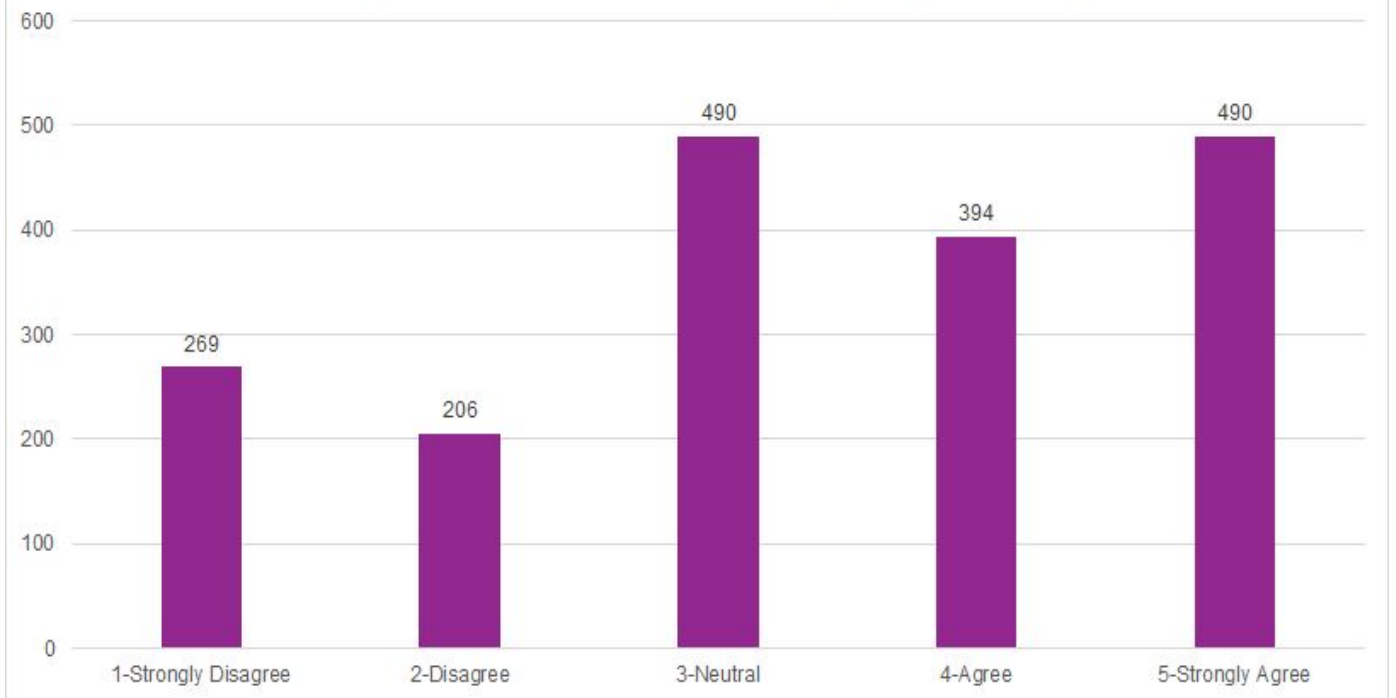

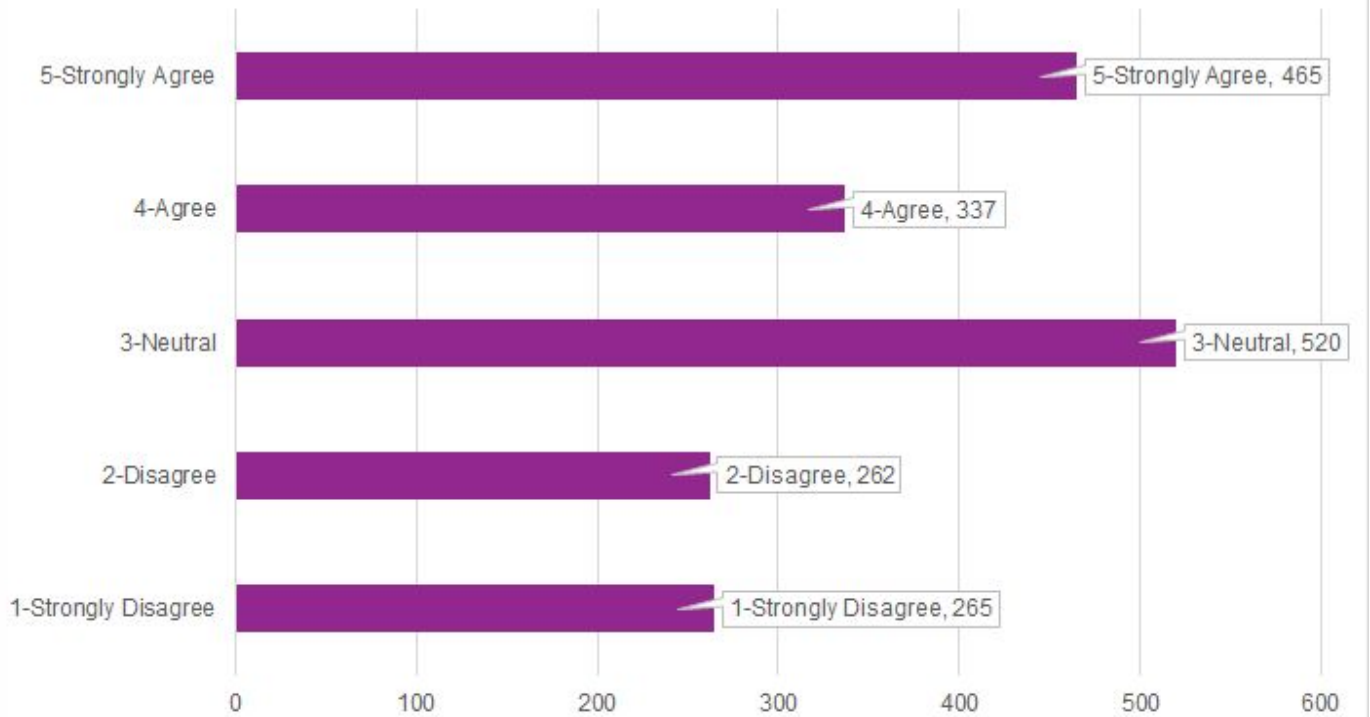

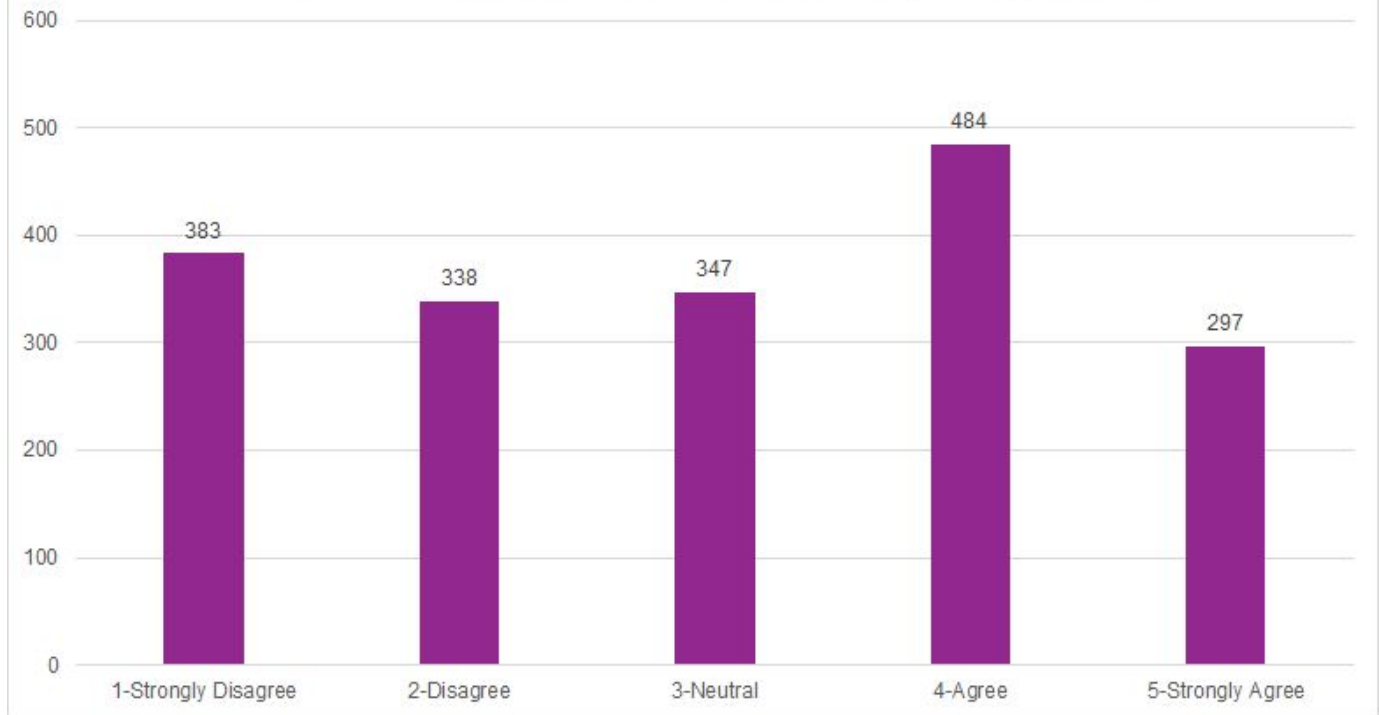

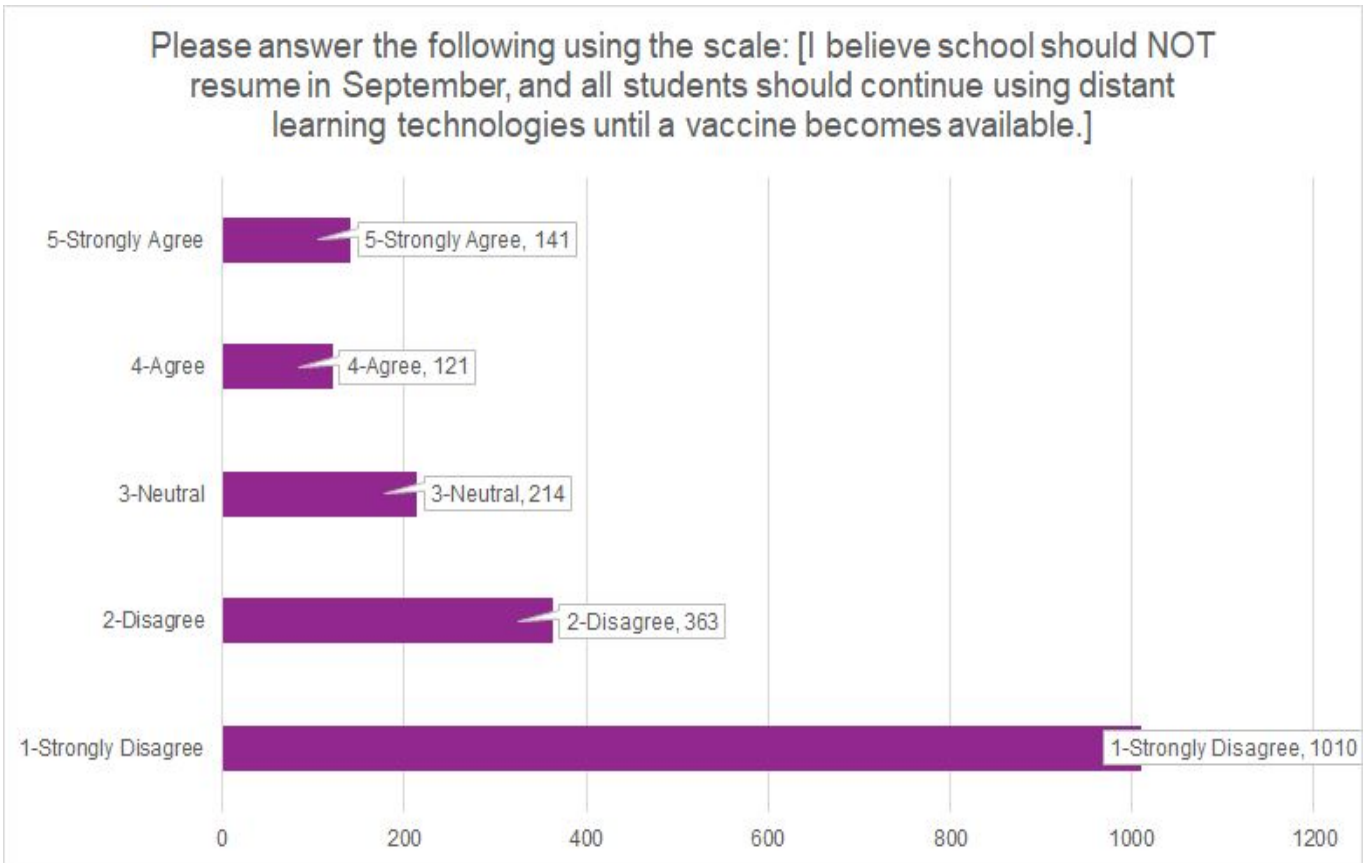

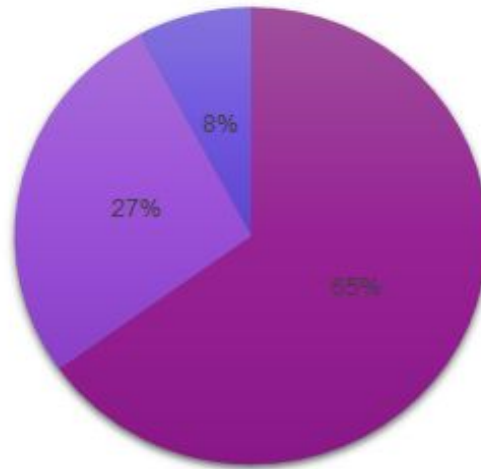

**What is your expectation regarding student athletics, performing arts, and extra-curricular activities if students return to school in the September?**

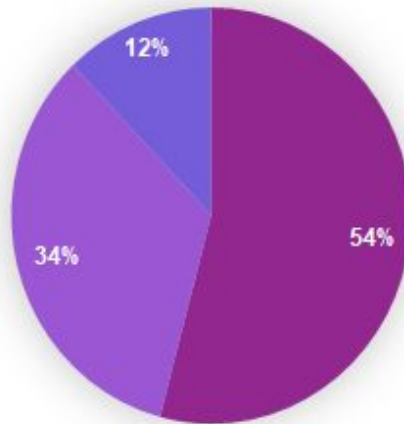
