Registration and payment with the Continuing Education Office are required BEFORE you will be permitted in class. Instructors will not accept course payment or registrations. They will accept lab fees ONLY, where noted. Please adhere to registration deadlines.

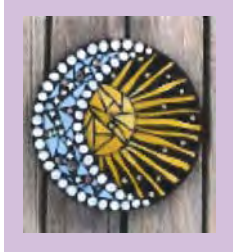

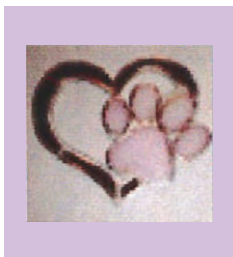

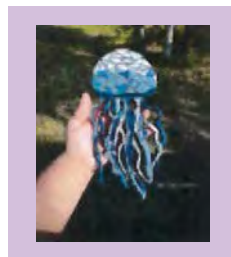

YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING (FN11)

Hamburg Central certified instructors

Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis. The course introduces common mental health challenges for youth, reviews typical adolescent development, and teaches a 5-step action plan for how to help young people in both crisis and non-crisis situations. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including AD/HD), and eating disorders. It teaches about recovery and resiliency - the belief that individuals experiencing these challenges can and do get better.

The course consists of 2 hours of online pre-work (to be completed on your own before the in-person meeting) and 3 hours of in-person instruction. Cost includes a manual.

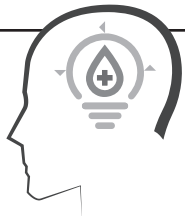

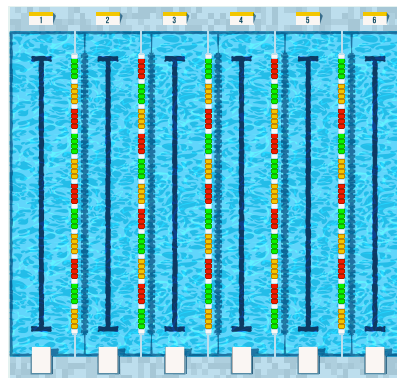

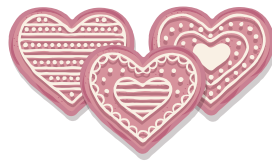
